#### READINGS

#### WORD

Christ assures His presence to those He commissions to proclaim the Kingdom of God.

#### ORDER

*“Go, therefore, and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you.” (Mt 28: 19-20)*

#### PROPHECIES

1. Let the grace and anointing of my Spirit be with you and embolden you to use your gifts to make disciples of all nations.
2. Do not grow weary; teach and proclaim the Good News of Salvation and I am with you until end of the world.

#### DIRECTION

1. In response to the new BLD Vision and Mission, exercise the gifts of the Holy Spirit and develop more witnesses for the Lord.

#### THEMES AND PROMISES

##### Week#1 (Solemnity of the Ascension of the Lord)

**Theme:** We proclaim the Kingdom of God when we make disciples of all nations.

**Promise:** *“And behold, I am with you always, until the end of age.” (Mt 28:20b)*

### **Week#2 (Pentecost Sunday)**

**Theme:** We proclaim the Kingdom of God when we exercise the gifts of the Holy Spirit.

**Promise:** *“When you send forth your spirit, they are created, and renew the face of the earth”* (Ps 104: 30)

### **Week #3 (Solemnity of the Most Blessed Trinity)**

**Theme:** We proclaim the Kingdom of God when we share our belief in the mystery of the Holy Trinity.

**Promise:** *“...everyone who believes in him might not perish but might have eternal life.”* (Jn 3: 16b)

### **Week #4 (Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ)**

**Theme:** We proclaim the Kingdom of God when we testify to the real presence of the body and blood of Christ in the Eucharist.

**Promise:** *“Whoever eats my flesh and drinks my blood remains in me and I in him.”* (Jn 6:56)
